This means that they will take good care of them, not have food or drinks when they are using them, leave them where they might be damaged or carry them by the screen. The laptops should be treated gently; they are school property and must be returned in good condition.

Students must remember to treat everyone with RESPECT when they are online. Do not post rude or unkind comments or send bullying messages. It would be very disappointing if we had to ask a parent to return the device their student is using because RESPECT had not been shown.

I am sure having devices at home will support student learning. Your child's teacher will let you know what website or apps we would like them to use. Teachers might send emails or have online meetings with students or the whole grade to teach something new or answer questions.

**We are all learning so it is okay to ask questions! You can ring the school or send an email to your child's teacher or the school and someone will answer your question as soon as possible.**

**Please remember that teachers work from 9am until 4pm. They have many things to do each day, contact students, answer student's questions, have online meetings as well as plan work for students to do. This means that sometimes you might have to wait before teachers are able to contact you.**
